
What is Review Manager?



- It is the software used for preparing and maintaining Cochrane protocols and reviews
- It allows you to:
 - prepare the text,
 - build tables showing characteristics of studies and the comparisons in the review,
 - manage references (i.e. sources you want to cite),
 - add study data,
 - perform meta-analyses,
 - present the results graphically,
 - avoid competing versions of text, and
 - submit drafts to editorial assessment (compulsory)



What is Archie?

- Cochrane Collaboration's central server for managing documents and contacts details
- What is it good for?
 - Finding contact details of fellow Cochranites (~30.000)
 - Keeping documents safe (e.g. drafts of protocols and reviews)
 - Only one person at a time can check out a draft into RevMan
 - ALWAYS check your work back in
 - NEVER save work only locally
 - Signing and storing electronic forms
 - conflict of interest form
 - license for publication form
- Within Archie it is possible to read, print and compare current and past versions of a document
